Editing the profile image

The profile image can be edited either through the TSPro app or tspro.app website

To edit the profile image from the TSPro app, once logged in, go to the "Settings" menu from the main menu

From the configuration menu, select the "General" item







From the "General" menu, scrolling down, select the item "Photo"



The system proposes the current profile picture that can be edited with the appropriate button

To change your profile picture from the tspro.app site, once logged in, select the 'Profile' item from the main menu
